



APRIL IS POETRY MONTH

First, Wes McNair will be at the Library Arts Center on Thursday, April 19 at 7:00 PM to read from his latest collection, **The Unfastening**.



NEW HAMPSHIRE STATE PARKS PASS

We will soon have passes available to New Hampshire State Parks! This will entitle the borrower to admission to all day-use parks for two adults and up to four dependents.
