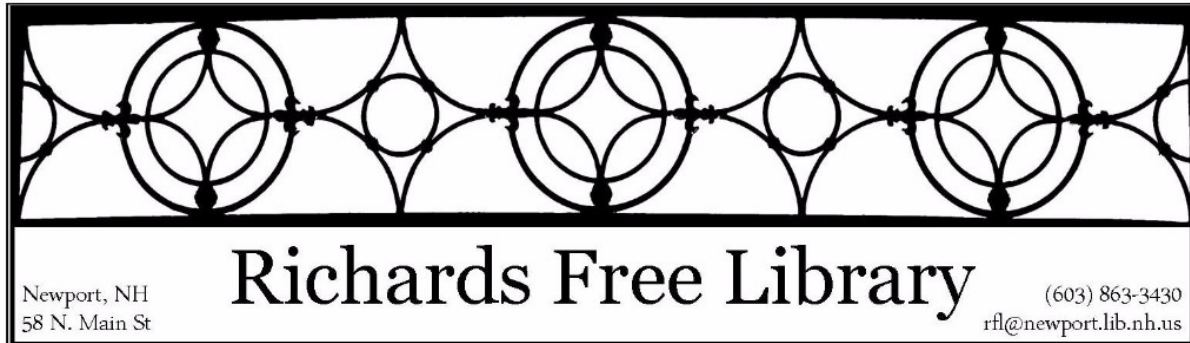

A notary public is now part of our staff on Tuesdays.

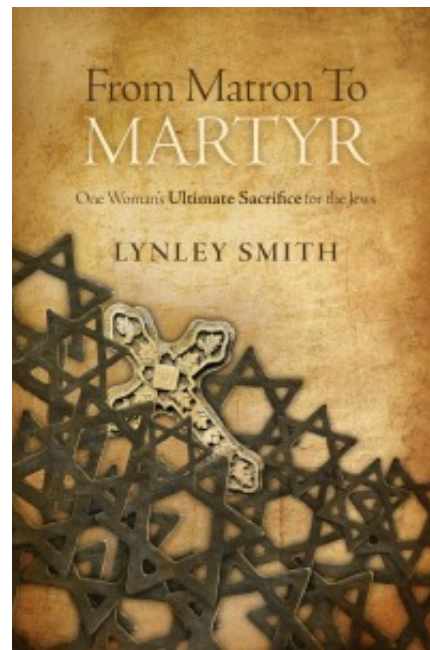
Please bring a valid photo I.D. and do not pre-sign documents.

The true story of a Scottish missionary, Jane Haining, who went to Budapest in Hungary to work as matron in the Girls' Home attached to the Scottish Mission to Budapest, in 1932. She remained there, refusing to return to Scotland in 1940 when the Church of Scotland ordered their missionaries home because of the onset of WW2. The others went, leaving Jane as the only foreign missionary at the

In 1944, Germany invaded Hungary, Jane was arrested and sent to Auschwitz-Birkenau Concentration Camp, where she died two months later, as a martyr for the Jewish children she refused to leave. Yad Vashem Holocaust Museum acknowledged her posthumously in 1997 as one of the Righteous Among the Nations.
