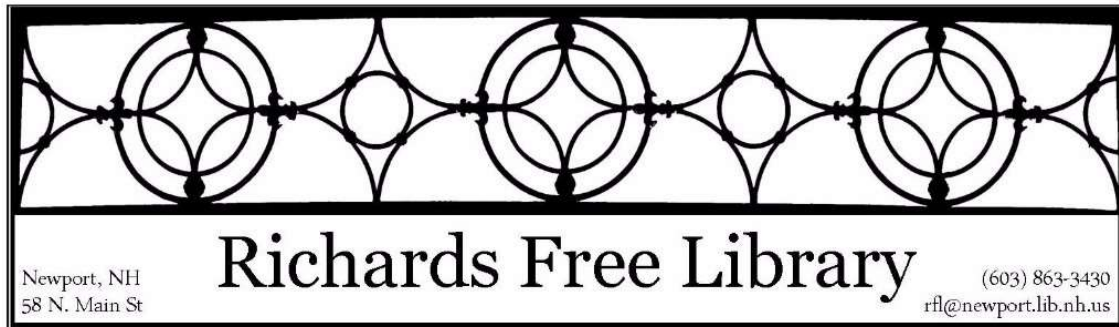

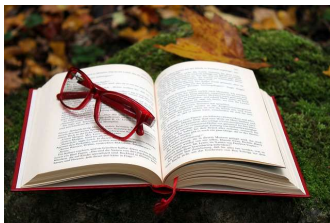
### PHOTOGRAPHS OF NEWPORT AND NORTH NEWPORT

communities of Goshen and Croydon. Rev. Yale was an accomplished lecturer, and an avid photographer. While residing in Newport (1918-1923) Rev. Yale took 186 photographs of Newport and North Newport, as well as three of Croydon and two of Goshen. He returned to Newport in 1937 to give a stereopticon lecture on the Earthly Life of Christ, and brought with him the photographs he took in 1921. He gifted two wooden boxes of glass lantern slides to the Richards Free Library. Those photographs are featured in this book, with captions reflecting Rev. Yale’s notes and labels. These books are available from the library for \$12.00.
