*Children of Blood and Bone* by Tomi Adeyemi. Coming of age in a land where her magi mother was killed by the zealous king's guards along with other former wielders of magic, Zelig embarks on a journey alongside her brother and a fugitive princess to restore her people's magical abilities.



*City of Bones* by Cassandra Clare. Suddenly able to see demons and the Darkhunters who are dedicated to returning them to their own dimension, fifteen-year-old Clary Fray is drawn into this bizarre world when her mother disappears and Clary herself is almost killed by a monster.



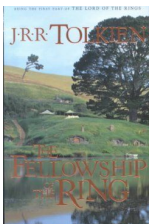

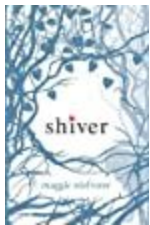

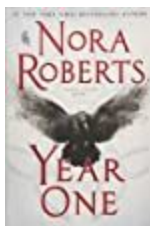
