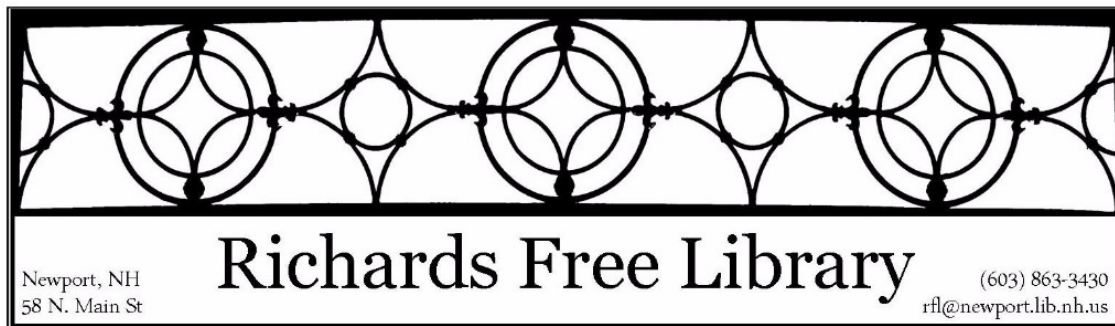

July 26th, 3:00 Frozen T-Shirt Challenge - The traditional Frozen T-Shirt Challenge is back! Don't miss this summer favorite! Here's what's happening: we freeze a bunch of t-shirts solid. Everybody gets a shirt, and when we shout "go," you have a chance to be the first person to thaw your shirt enough to get it all the way on. Prizes go to the first three contestants to complete the challenge, but everyone gets to take their frozen t-shirt home.
