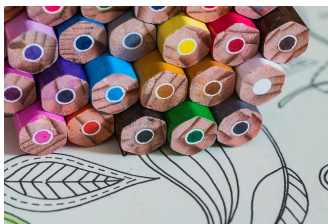
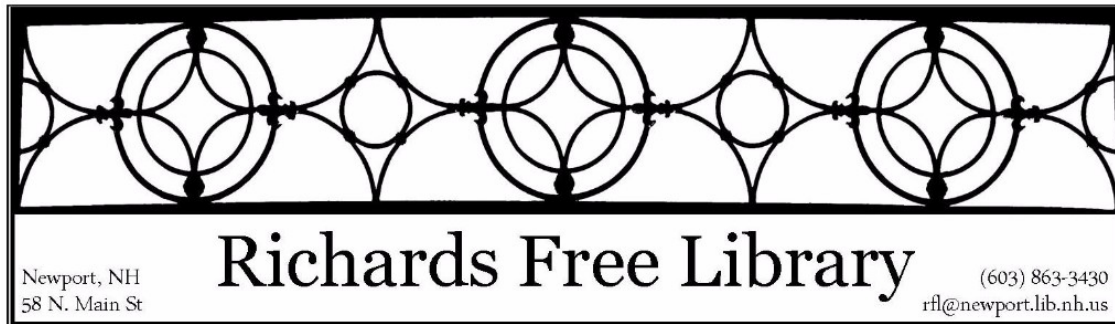

NO MORE FESTIVAL BOOKS!

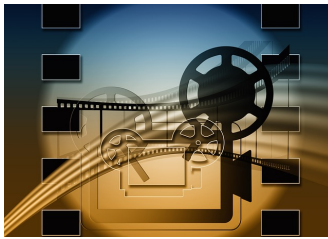
Due to everyone's overwhelming generosity, our festival book storage area is full. We are unable to take any more books until September, after the festival. Thank you for your support!
