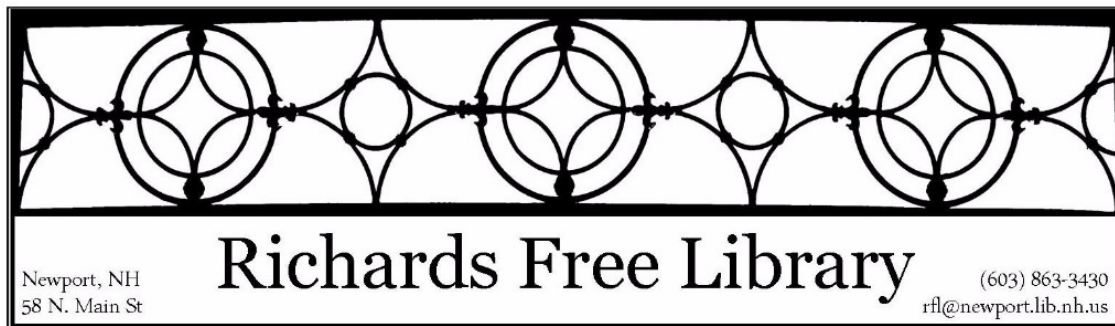

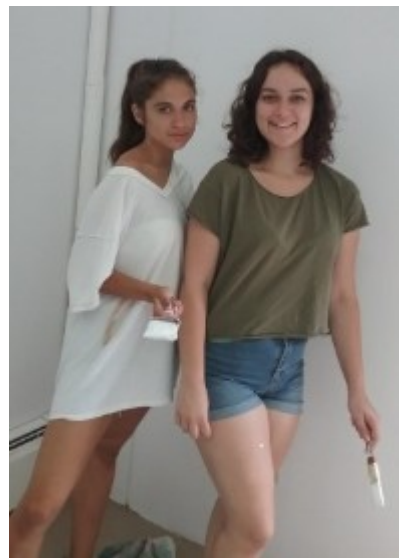


### STUDENT HELP WANTED

Join us for for our annual festival! The Book Tent opens at 9:00 AM, with admission at 8:00 AM for Friends of the Library (you can join that morning!).

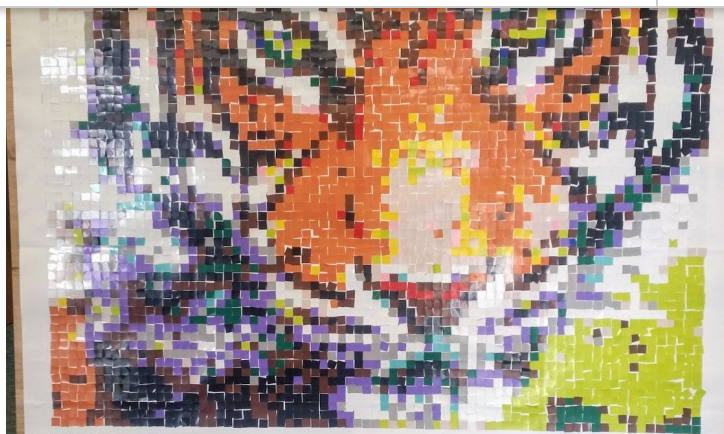
Activities include:
